Sub: Guidelines in respect of Tiger Conservation Plan for the Tiger Reserves -reg.

Sir,

This is for your kind information that, Guidelines for preparation of Tiger Conservation Plan was issued vide NTCA/01/07 and further supplementary guidance was issued vide No. 1-14/2011-NTCA (Part-1) dated 2nd April'2014. However, the status of preparation and submission of Tiger Conservation Plan is not satisfactory and there is no time line adhered to.

- 2. In order to streamline the process of preparation, submission and approval of TCP, it has been decided that,
 - a) Tiger Conservation Plan of the Tiger Reserve shall be prepared well in advance and sent to this Authority at least 6 months before the completion of plan period. The approved TCP shall be uploaded in the website of concerned Tiger Reserve and the confirmation may be sent to this authority.
 - b) For the Tiger Reserves to be newly formed, the draft TCP should be part of the proposal failing which the proposal will not be considered for approval.
- 3. It is requested that, the Time line may be strictly followed so that the preparation and approval of TCP be taken up smoothly.
- 4. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
