INSPIRING BEST TEACHER AWARD 2017

Performance of students at NPTEL

UEM Kolkata students' performances in NPTEL examinations in September-October cycle have been ranked No. 1 pan India. Around 4 lacs registrations were there in that cycle. IEM has ranked 4th overall India basis/nationally.

NPTEL stands for National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning which is an initiative by seven Indian Institutes of Technology (IIT Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras and Roorkee) and Indian Institute of Science (IISc) for creating course contents in engineering and science.



A proposal was jointly put forward by five IITs (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur and Madras) and IISc for creating contents for 100 courses as web based supplements and 100 complete video courses, for forty hours of duration per course. Web supplements were expected to cover materials that could be delivered in approximately forty hours. Five engineering branches (Civil, Computer Science, Electrical, Electronics and Communication and Mechanical) and core science programmes that all engineering students are required to take in their Undergraduate Engineering Programme in India were chosen initially. Contents for the above courses were based on the model curriculum suggested by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and the syllabi of major affiliating Universities in India.

Kolkata: Bengal's educational institutes have fallen far short of expectation with only 10 making it to the HRD ministry's 250-strong national institutional rankings. IIT-Kharagpur and IIM-Calcutta are the only two exceptions. Both bagged third spots in their respective categories: top-100 engineering institutes and top-50 management schools. Jadavpur University and Calcutta University find no mention in the list of top-100 universities. Authorities of the two universities claimed they did not participate in the ranking but could not provide a credible reason why they chose not to. "We did not participate largely because our database could not be prepared to adequately fill the proforma. We have now created a new infrastructure, I have addressed the problem and next year will participate in the process," said JU vice-chancellor Suranjan Das. Calcutta University had a different reason to share. "When we received the notification, the data requirement of NAAC and NIRF were found to be different. Since we were gearing up for a NAAC visit, we could not have participated simultaneously in both the ranks," said pro-VC (academics) Swagata Sen.

"The total number of candidates who applied for GATE 2017 were 9,22,167. Just 1,29,149 candidates qualified in the exam," said Govind Chakrapani, chairman of GATE 2017 committee from IIT-Roorkee - the organizing institute.

Himadri Sekhar Bandyopadhyay, a Institute of Engineering and Management - Salt Lake student, has ranked 15 in computer science and engineering. "It's a tough call between IISc-Bangalore and IIT-Bombay. I would prefer technological research more than academic research," he added.
