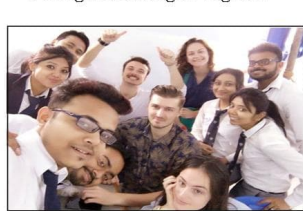
Competition on "DEMONETIZATION"

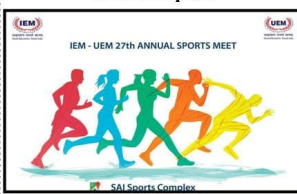
Cricket Tournament
