 2. Prof. Sanghamitra Poddar once while teaching values and ethics in class mentioned about two girls among whom one was Hindu and one was Muslim who stayed in the same room have to divide the fridge because of halal meat and non halal meat and because of that her friends started abusing her which made her disturbed.
 3. She mailed to Prof. Malay Gangopadhyaya, HOD of ECE Department, and Prof. Arunava Mukhopadhyay in order to change her project mentor and give her an extension for submission of the project but none of them agreed.

- b. She mailed to Prof. Malay Gangopadhyaya, HOD of ECE Department, and Prof. Arunava Mukhopadhyay in order to change her project mentor and give her an extension for submission of the project but none of them agreed.
- c. During her mini-project presentation Prof. T.K.Rana had scolded her alone for not doing the project properly although there were 4 group members. She claimed that the reason for such behavior was as she belongs to the minority community.
- d. Prof. Mili Sarkar had graded one of her papers 14 out of 25 which she didn't deserve and she was being discriminated against for belonging to the minority community.









The Resolution Of the meeting is:
