

CÔTE D'IVOIRE - CI

Jurisdiction - General Information

Côte d'Ivoire has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since October 23, 1963. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since April 30, 1991, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI). In addition, it is a party to the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Côte d'Ivoire is a member of the Organisation Africaine de la Propriété Intellectuelle ([OAPI](#)).
