Jurisdiction - General Information

Algeria has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since March 1, 1966. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since March 8, 2000. In addition, it is a party to the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Algeria has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#).

Features and search functionalities

The Online Register has an **Arabic, English, French** and **Japanese interface**.

The Online Register has been made with the platform WIPO Publish, allowing a selection through a filter by application type (PCT, national patent, 'certificate d'addition') and several other data or a search in a number of text or alphanumeric fields predetermined by default that can be extended according to the user's choice.

The publication coverage is from 2003.12.01 to 2014.12.01.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on PCT **National Phase Entry** and **Legal Status**.

The Online Register can also be searched by **PCT Application Number**, by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, and by **Priority Data**.

The Online Gazette is published quarterly in French. Its current coverage (Patent section) is from October 2003 to December 2014 and from June 2021 to present, however only few gazettes include patent data.

Search tips

The patent register can be searched by **PCT Application Number**, e.g. "001201" for "PCT/EP2006/001201" and by **Applicant/Inventor Name**.

Priority Data search is possible by priority number, e.g. "764976" for "US12/764976".

In the **Online Register**, select "Advanced" to search by numbers, dates or technology, select "Basic" to search by **Applicant/Inventor Name**.

An example of data reported as a basic **Legal Status** is, e.g., "Registration Number", "Registration Date".
