Jurisdiction - General Information

Ukraine has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since December 25, 1991. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure and the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Ukraine has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#).

Features and search functionalities

The Online Register has an **English** and **Ukrainian interface**. It contains information about Ukrainian patents and utility models.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on PCT **National Phase Entry**, **Fee Payment**, **Legal Status**, and access the **Full Publications**.

The Online Register can also be searched by **PCT Application Number**, by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, and by **Priority Data**.

The Online Gazette is published weekly in Ukrainian. The coverage is 20/2020 to present (new format) and from 2008 to 19/2020 (old format).

Search tips

The Ukrainian IP Office offers a bundle of patent databases. In the Online Register you can search by **PCT Application Number**, e.g., "(86) PCT Application Number" PCT/CN03/00069.

PCT National Phase Entry information is reported on the "Details" page; see INID code 85.

To retrieve information about **Legal Status**, see the color of the button on the top right corner of the "Details" page, and the wording, eg. red button "Invalid" for patent no. 77250.

Fee Payment information is available, e.g. see a yellow button with wording like "Ceased to be effective, but is subject to renewal" or "First maintenance fee expected" on the top right corner of the "Details" page.

Patents **Full Publications** are available but split in their different components.
