## **Jurisdiction - General Information**

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since September 12, 1995. It is not a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT).

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela is also part of the regional IP information platform LATIPAT.

#### Features and search functionalities

The Online Register has a Spanish interface.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on **Legal Status** and access the **Full Publications**.

Through the Online Register one can search by Applicant Name.

To access the Online Register click on "Busqueda Avanzada" in the menu provided under the tab "Patentes".

The Online Gazette is published every one/two months in Spanish. Its current coverage is from 2017 to May 2022. The most recent ones are available for a fee. An archive including gazettes since 2008 is available at this <u>link</u>.
