- A.) Favors the Unicode code-point glyph (as Jirimutu said is developer-friendly) – Baiti and Bolorsoft
- B.) Favors the isolate (as Jirimutu said is user-friendly) – FangZhen and NotoSans
- C.) Favors the isolate and the initial (as Jirimutu said is user-friendly) – White and Menksoft


