#### **COMMON BUZZARD** (Buteo buteo)

#### **IDENTIFICATION**

51-56 cm. Species with very variable plumage since dark to very pale pattern; usually with brown upperparts; pale streaked or crossbarring underparts; dark upperwing and paler underwing with primaries tipped black; dark and barred tail; dark bill; brown eye.

#### **SIMILAR SPECIES**

Quite similar to **Honey Buzzard**, with orange or yellow iris. **Booted Eagle** lacks dark patch on underwing and has feathered legs. **Red Kite** and **Black Kite** have forked tails.









#### **SEXING**

Plumage of both sexes alike. **Male** usually with smaller size than **female**, but many birds cannot be sexed due to considerable overlap in measurements.

#### **AGEING**

4 types of age can be recognized:

**Juvenile** with fresh plumage; upperwing coverts brown with pale tips and edges; underparts with longitudinal streaks; dark subterminal tail band narrow and similar in width to the other tail bars; pale brown iris.

**2nd year autumn/3rd year spring** with body feathers with adult pattern but with juvenile two to five outermost primaries and some secondaries, shorter and worn than the neighbors; some birds can retain the outermost tail feathers.

**3rd year autumn/4th year spring** only in birds with some juvenile outermost primaries retained, which is strongly worn.

**Adult** without juvenile feathers on body, tail or wing; wing coverts uniform dark brown; underparts horizontally cross-barred; dark subterminal tail band wider than the other tail bars; dark brown iris.





C o m m o n B u z z a r d . A g e i n g . Pattern of g r e a t e r coverts: top adult; bottom juvenile.



#### **MOULT**

Complete **postbreeding** moult, usually finished in October. **Postjuvenile** moult starts with body feathers in November; tail and wing feathers start their moult since March in their **2nd year** retaining unmoulted two to five outer primaries and some secondaries; some **3rd year** birds retain one or two outermost primaries till their moult in **4th year**.

#### STATUS IN ARAGON

Resident, with contribution of wintering European birds: Widely distributed throughout the Region, absent only from the most deforested areas.
