Subject: Does the Commission recognise Member States' sovereignty to hold elections?

On 15 January 2025, Politico quoted an unnamed EU diplomat as allegedly claiming that 'the EU should consider starting Article 7 proceedings – penalties that can culminate in a country's exclusion from EU decision-making – against both Hungary and Austria to send a signal to France, where far-right leader Marine Le Pen is eyeing a fourth run for the presidency in 2027'<sup>1</sup>.

- 2. Is the Commission able to guarantee that it will not start Article 7 proceedings or take other measures against sovereign EU Member States after they have held national elections?
