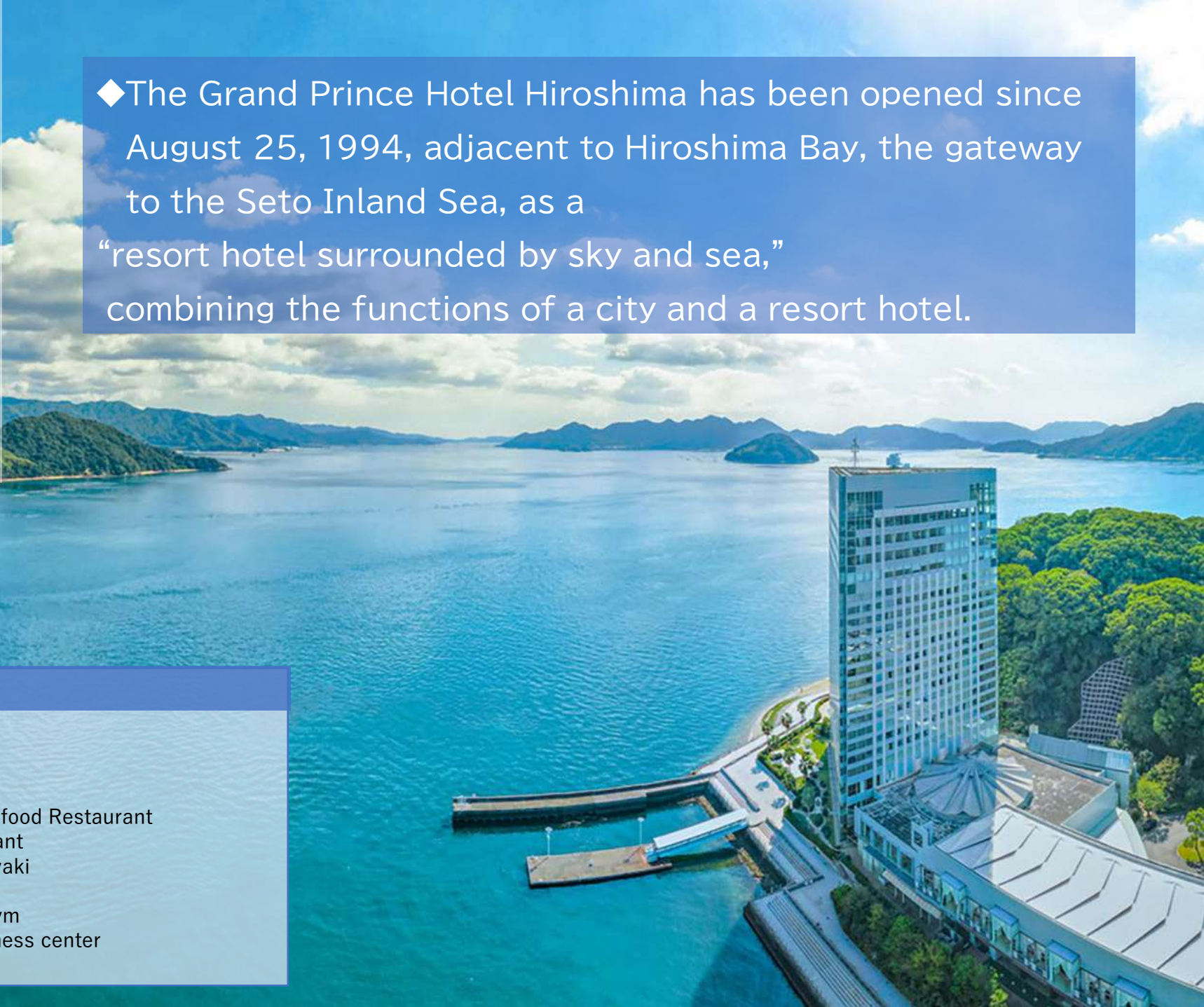

What you can do in our hotel...

Panoramic view of the Seto Inland Sea!

You can only see it here!

From the guest rooms and the Sky Lounge on the top floor of the hotel, you can enjoy the view of the Seto Inland Sea and the islands of the Seto region as it changes from a refreshing blue to an azure hue. From autumn through winter, you can watch the sunset over Miyajima, the UNESCO World heritage, the island of the gods.



What you can do in our hotel...

Easy access to two World Heritage sites in Hiroshima Prefecture!

Located in a resort area with spectacular views, yet within easy access to the World Heritage Sites of Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima and the Atomic Bomb Dome.

- 26 minutes by high-speed boat to Miyajima, where Itsukushima Shrine is located.
- 20 minutes by car to the Atomic Bomb Dome



World Heritage Site Itsukushima Shrine

Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima is one of the most famous shrines in Japan, known worldwide for its "Floating Torii Gate." It was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996. Miyajima can be reached in about 26 minutes by high-speed boat leaving from the pier in front of the hotel.



World Heritage Site Atomic Bomb Dome

The Atomic Bomb Dome is a building that was exposed to the atomic bomb. It remains as it was at the time of the bombing and is registered as a World Cultural Heritage Site as a peace monument that continues to advocate for the abolition of nuclear weapons and the importance of eternal world peace. It takes about 20 minutes to reach by car from the hotel!

We also provide relaxation facilities, such as Hiroshima Hot Spring "Seto-no-yu", where you can unwind with a view of the ever-changing Seto Inland Sea, and Spa The Blue Prince, where you can experience an original spa treatment plan that incorporates the blessings of nature.

Introducing sightseeing routes that can be enjoyed from the hotel

We also offer a bicycle tour to the Peace Memorial Park, suggesting sightseeing that makes the most of our location.

Take a high-speed boat to Miyajima!

Tour the islands on the Setouchi Shimatabi Line!

The Setouchi Shimatabi Line is a cruise to the Setouchi islands by the sightseeing high-speed cruiser "SEA SPICA." The line runs for about half a day between Hiroshima Port and Mihara Port, and boarding is available at the pier in front of the hotel.



Original bicycle tour to downtown Hiroshima!

This is the hotel's original route where a local guide will take you to Peace Memorial Park and the Atomic Bomb Dome while visiting peaceful and historical spots that were exposed to radiation. You will experience a new sightseeing attraction in Hiroshima through a photogenic tour that blends history with the natural beauty of Hiroshima and the Seto Inland Sea, while enjoying local talk as only a local guide can.
